What do we want?

We want to make sure this is a positive ending

We want to ensure our personal journey continues

How will we achieve this?

Ensure everyone has been able to wrap up what they've enjoyed working on

Re-frame thoughts - not finding a 'replacement' to BHCA but focussing on our next steps

This could be as a group or individually, if our work continues elsewhere we want to be informed

Co-define our legacy, follow up on where we have had impact and encourage adoption and spread

Host a celebration and showcase event in November

Co-produce ending messaging and blogs

Understanding what other opportunities are out there

We will set up a Whatsapp group to stay in touch and share opportunities we find and meet up

Hold a website meeting to discuss its future and how partner orgs can support this

We will have a Christmas party for members instead of our last session before Christmas

Co-define the project and its impact

Work through move on options in our 1-1 space with the Participation Lead

We want to be able to continue to write blogs and add them to the website

Meet with BHCC housing to understand how our housing pathway work can be adopted here

We will also have a meal together after Christmas

A reflection session to identify the positive impact of the project on the group and each of us individually

Co-develop a portfolio of work done both for us to use in our next step and to show to others in the future

Every member has ownership of our work and will be able to take it with them wherever they go next

Meet with Dr Kate Pitt to look at the next steps for our co-designed medical student training

Host an informal celebration event in February to share our final work and learning

Get certificates from The Health Foundation to use in our portfolios

We will look at how the university may be able to continue the co-production training development

For our last session in March we will meet as usual for a short wrap up and then do something fun together

A point of contact at partner organisations (Arch, Justlife, Uni of Brighton) when project staff leave

Meet with street support and antifreeze to ensure our route to roof ideas are taken onboard

Project Staff and Partner Organisations providing references, both now and in the future

Document our 'positive ending', how we made it safe and co-produced to share with other services
